- Destroyed twelve months after you leave our employment or only after no longer required by law We will be undertaking performance appraisals as part of your employment and copies of the reports from these (along with all documents supplied as part of your application) will be kept securely in the Church Office or in a password protected section of our church computer which can only be accessed by the Trustee with oversight of your role. If appropriate, information from these documents may be shared with other charity Trustees but will NOT be shared with anyone else without your consent.
